



Oswaldo Perez y Perez and his brothers founded "Flor del Café" in 1940 and began growing Typica on the 5.6 hectares of land. In 1982 Oswaldo's three songs took management of the farm and expanded the program by introducing new varieties, better planting. harvesting, and processing techniques, and acquiring nearby land. In 1992, the youngest son, Oswaldo, purchased the farm from his brothers and established Finca Flor del Café, totaling 105 hectares of coffee and 35 hectares of untouched tropical rainforest. The farm now has its own wet mill, housing for 150 permanent residents, and large main farmhouse.
